AWARDS

1. (i) **First award Rs. 51,000/-**
(ii) **Second award Rs. 31,000/-**
(iii) **Ten awards Rs. 21,000/- each**
(iv) **Two Silver Plaques out of these Twelve will also be awarded as under :-**
 - a) **S.G. Thakur Singh Memorial Award**
 - b) **S. Dharam Singh Engineer Memorial Award**
 - (v) **Ten Cash Awards of Excellence with cash Rs. 1100/- each will also be awarded.**
 - (vi) **Besides an invitation to inauguration, each participant will be entitled to a catalogue and participation certificate to short-listed candidates whose works are selected for the Exhibition .**
2. **It will not be binding on the Jury to give away all the awards. Awards must meet the standards of National Level. But no award will be split up into lesser amount.**

ENTRY FEE

3. **The entry fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rs. One Thousand only) per schedule should be remitted by Bank Draft in favour of Indian Academy of Fine Arts or paid in Cash to *The Indian Academy of Fine Arts, Amritsar* or by *NEFT / RTGS*. The UTR No. of RTGS / NEFT must be mentioned **clearly** on the form to avoid any **overlapping**. However if consolidated amount of more than one artist is made through RTGS or NEFT. The UTR No. will be clearly mentioned in all the application form by making it by (/)Slash, (for example Artist Rohit made payment of Rs. 5000/- in single RTGS / NEFT. Rohit will inform the office by making it clear UTR/1-Rohit, UTR/2-Second Name, UTR/3-.....).The form can be downloaded from official website**

of Indian Academy of Fine Arts, Amritsar (www.indianacademyoffinearts.com) and uploaded the same at website. (Please follow instructions in the rules & regulations section).

PROGRAMME

4. There will be a Two-stage Jury. First for selection of Works & Second for Awards. **Artists need not send their original works for first selection.** Only photograph of his/her Works for the selection can be sent on or before 20th August, 2019 with Entry Form and Fee, you can also send photographs of works with minimum resolution of 300 dpi at **E-mail : amritsargallery2018@gmail.com or at the official website www.indianacademyoffinearts.com**
- (i) These Photographs will not be returned.
- (ii) Write the following details behind the photographs :- Artist name, Title, Size, Medium, Address, Phone No. & E-Mail Address.
- Judges will select the works for display and final jury, which shall be intimated to participants through WhatsApp, personal calls, The result will also be available on the facebook page of I.A.F.A. and official website of I.A.F.A.
- (iii) The above Selected Artists should send their Original work on or before **22nd Sept., 2019.**
- (iv) The Final Judgement will be done from amongst the Original Works only and the concerned Award Winner Artists will be informed on or before 1st Oct., 2019.
- (v) The decision of the jury will be final in matter of selection and judging, no communication on this subject will be entertained.

GENERAL

5. Sculptures should be made of durable material, such as metal, wood, stone, marble, plastic, fibre-glass etc. **SCULPTURES OF PLASTER OF PARIS, GLASS, CLAY, PAPER, CEMENT OR ANY OTHER FRAGILE OR FLIMSY MATERIAL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
6. Exhibitors should inform the Indian Academy of Fine Arts, Amritsar of any change in their address immediately. The Academy will not be responsible for despatch which may go astray on account of incorrect address.
7. For better sale, the Artists should price their exhibits reasonably. 12.5% of the sale proceeds of the exhibits will be deducted by the Academy in case of sale.
8. Failure to comply with any of the rules laid down in the Prospectus may cause rejection of exhibits.

EXHIBITS

9. Not more than Two works in each category with two photographs by an artist will be considered for selection and size of Exhibits should not exceed 36"x48". **(Over Size will not be considered).**
10. Exhibits, which have already been awarded in any exhibition, must be mentioned.
11. The Academy reserves the right to reproduce any exhibit accepted for the exhibition.
12. No exhibit will be presented to the Jury for selection unless the entry fee in full has been received by the Academy.
13. No exhibitor, whose works have been displayed, will be allowed to remove any exhibit submitted before the end of the exhibition unless permitted to do so in writing by the Honorary General Secretary of the Academy.
14. Water colour exhibits must be suitably framed and mounted.
15. Each exhibit must have two labels, one pasted on the reverse of the exhibit and the other tagged to it with a strong thread. Labels are supplied with the prospectus.

16. The enclosed schedule must be filled in properly and posted or delivered personally to the Indian Academy of Fine Arts, Amritsar.

Note : Photocopy performa of schedule will also be accepted.

17. The exhibitor should state whether his/her entry is a painting, graphic, drawing, sculpture or photography (Digital or Natural).

PACKING AND DESPATCH

18. Exhibits should be packed in strong cases to withstand rail transport. The Academy will not be responsible for refusal by Railway of packages regarded unsuitable for rail transport.

19. Exhibitors are advised to despatch cases under Railway transit insurance at their own expenses to ensure careful handling by railway.

20. All packages containing exhibits for the exhibition despatched by rail, road, air or post should be marked.

21. All Packages should be freight-paid and addressed to Honorary Secretary, Indian Academy of Fine Arts, Madan Mohan Malviya Road, Amritsar.

22. Exhibits sent by Rail, Road, Air, Post Parcel should be despatched so as to reach Amritsar before **22nd Sept., 2019.**

23. To ensure safe delivery of the exhibits, the Academy has decided to pay second class one side railway fare to any one artist who brings art works of at least ten artists for exhibition. Similarly one side 2nd class railway fare will be paid to the artist who takes back the art works of at least ten participant artists for delivering the same to them within one month after the expiry of exhibition. The freight/packing charges etc. may be borne by respective artists proportionately.

24. Exhibits may be delivered at the Academy's

Office during working hours on all working days upto 22nd Sept., 2019.

25. The Academy will not be responsible for not taking delivery of the parcels or for payment of demurrage caused by the non-receipt or late receipt of Parcel Way Bill or misplacement of consignment by Railway, Roadways, Airways etc.
26. **THE ACADEMY WILL ENDEAVOUR TO TAKE EVERY POSSIBLE CARE OF EXHIBITS SUBMITTED BUT WILL NOT BE LIABLE TO COMPENSATE ANY DAMAGE OR LOSS DURING TRANSIT OR WHILE IN THE CUSTODY OF THE ACADEMY. EXHIBITORS, IF THEY SO DESIRE, MAY GET THEIR EXHIBITS INSURED.**

RETURN OF EXHIBITS

27. Exhibits despatched from outstation will be packed & returned at the Exhibitor's risk & cost within one month after the close of the exhibition and for this purpose exhibitor is requested to deposit amount to cover the return journey and packing expenses of the exhibits without which the exhibits will not be returned. Please send separate DD for return charges and do not include it with Entry Fee. Please send separate DD for each participant.
28. Exhibitors personally submitting their exhibits must take these back within **ONE MONTH** after the close of the Exhibition. If the exhibits are not taken back within a month after the close of the Exhibition, the Academy shall have the right to dispose off the exhibits in any manner as it deems fit and Artist will have no claim against the Academy whatsoever.
